Summary

Definitions

The Stormwind Law - The current law book written by the Ministry of Justice for application of criminal justice in the Kingdom of Stormwind. (Example)

Revisions

Removal of Pirate Groups from the List of "Enemies of the Crown", to be handled by the Alliance Piracy Act instead.

Adding the following Section under "Other Procedures"

Section 5: Enemies of the Crown

Within the Kingdom of Stormwind, Enemies of the Crown are to be detained or killed on sight. Civilians are advised to get Guards to deal with them, but may also do so themselves at their own risk.

Detained Enemies of the Crown are to be Exiled or Executed.

A Bounty of One Gold Coin is paid by the Crown for any proven Enemy of the Crown within the Kingdom of Stormwind that is brought in, Dead or Alive.

As of Year 635, the following Organisations are considered Enemies of the Crown:

- The Defias Brotherhood
- The Scarlet Crusade
- The Syndicate
- Cult of the Damned
- The Twilight Hammer Cult
- The Primalists
- The Druids of the Flame

This definition does not apply to Enemies of War, such as the Horde. Refer to other Procedures instead
